



Use of Cannabis Rules and Procedures

The Micro Boutique Living **Use of Cannabis Rules and Procedures** have been established to ensure that the health, comfort, and safety of all members of our residential community, as well their guests, is our priority.

Anyone under the age of nineteen (19) may not use cannabis at any time. This is in compliance with the province of Nova Scotia's Cannabis Control Act.

As Micro Boutique Living is a smoke-free building, and, in compliance with smoking laws and regulations, smoking of any kind is strictly prohibited anywhere in the building. This includes outdoor areas such as the balconies and around entrances. Smoking any tobacco product, e-cigarettes (vaping), or marijuana (cannabis) are prohibited on MBL's property or within 3 metres of the property.

If you wish to smoke, please do so at least 3 metres away from the property. Anyone in violation of the smoking terms will be subject to a \$300.00 fine.

Should a resident of Micro Boutique Living, who is of legal age, nineteen (19) years of age or older, choose to consume cannabis **away** from the building and return to their suite, they will be expected to:

- consume in a responsible manner and moderate their own behaviour
- respect the rights of others who choose not to consume cannabis and ensure they are not subject to possible harms from the actions of any individuals who are consuming
- act immediately to help someone intoxicated or in the act of becoming over intoxicated
- obey all MBL's house rules in particular with regards to listed quiet times and parties

It is important to understand that intoxication in no way releases any individual from full and complete responsibility for their behaviour and its consequences.

General Rules and Regulations

Individuals who are nineteen (19) years of age may possess cannabis in their suite or on their person under the following conditions:

1. Cannabis must be stored in a sealed, airtight container so that a discernible odor is not noticeable outside of a suite.
2. Consumption of cannabis via smoking is **not** permitted anywhere in the building or within 3 metres of the property.
3. The production, sale, or purchase of edibles and oils is not permitted in Micro Boutique Living's building. This includes any cooking, baking, or boiling as discernable odours are created.

4. Cannabis plants may not be grown or stored on Micro Boutique Living's property including on balconies.
5. Drug Paraphernalia must be kept out of general sight and in a location in which potential smell is not discernable.
6. The quantity of cannabis must not exceed the legal limit of 30 grams of cannabis.

Definitions

1. **Underage Consumption** is defined as the consumption of cannabis by an individual who is less than the legal age for cannabis consumption in the province of Nova Scotia (19 years of age).
2. **Underage Possession** is defined as the possession of cannabis by an individual who is less than the legal age for cannabis possession in the province of Nova Scotia (19 years of age).
3. **Stockpiling of Cannabis** is defined as the possession of more than 30 grams of cannabis for individual consumption or distribution.
4. **Drug Paraphernalia** are defined as any item used to facilitate the consumption of cannabis.
5. **Edibles** are defined as any food item containing cannabis that is intended to be consumed.
6. **Dealing** is defined as illegally providing others with cannabis in exchange for financial profit.

Penalties

Should a resident of Micro Boutique Living violate the no-smoking policy of the building, they will be subject to a \$300.00 fine.

Should a resident of Micro Boutique Living be found in violation of any of the other rules concerning cannabis, they will be subject to Micro Boutique Living's House Rule Violation Policy and Procedures.
